



Knights of the Southern Cross **“Adopt a Chaplain in Training” Project** **2011 - Details**

- All Catholics and Catholic Organisations are invited to contribute towards the cost of training prospective Catholic military chaplains in 2011.
- It is suggested that this could be done by having a special dinner possibly during the 5th National Prayer Crusade for Vocations period from 4 Sep – 26 Nov 2011. Alternatively, donations can be made to assist this cause.
- The money raised or donated should be forwarded by cheque to Knights of the Southern Cross (Australia), PO Box 216, Campbell ACT 2612 – **the cheque to be made out to the Armed Services Catholic Diocese Revenue Fund.**
- The name of the individual Catholic or organisation and postal address must be included with the cheque for tax receipt purposes.
- The National Executive Officer, KSC will pass the cheque to Bishop Davis, Military Ordinary of Australia, for the issuing of a receipt. **All donations of \$2.00 or more are tax deductible.** Donations will be used as and where required by the Bishop.
- Each participating Catholic or organisation will be able to “adopt” and write to 1 chaplain in training if they wish – the National Executive Officer, KSC will supply contact details upon request.
- By participating in the initiative, you will know that you are doing something concrete (in addition to your already proven prayers) to provide chaplains for the Armed Forces.
- **All Catholic schools and colleges around Australia, as well as members of the Knights of the Southern Cross are being given the opportunity to participate in this project as well.**
