



## **Knights of the Southern Cross** **“Adopt a Chaplain in Training” Project**

### **Details**

- All schools and colleges throughout Australia are invited to adopt a chaplain in training and to help cover his training costs in 2010.
- It is suggested that this could be done by having a Gold Coin Day during the National Prayer Crusade period from 5 Sep – 27 Nov 2010 (possibly in the week they have chosen for the Crusade).
- The money raised should be forwarded by cheque to Knights of the Southern Cross (Australia), PO Box 216, Campbell ACT 2612 – **the cheque is to be made out to the Armed Services Catholic Diocese Revenue Fund.**
- Details of the school/college and postal address must be supplied with the cheque for tax receipt purposes.
- The National Executive Officer, KSC will pass the cheque to Bishop Davis, Military Ordinary of Australia, for the issuing of a receipt. **All donations of \$2.00 or more are tax deductible.**
- The National Executive Officer will record details of the school/college and amount raised.
- **The name of 1 chaplain in training will be given to each participating school and college.**
- Participating schools/colleges are encouraged to correspond with their adopted chaplain in training and he might be able to visit them if they are located in Melbourne or Brisbane, where the chaplains are studying.
- Even if the chaplains in training cannot physically visit all supporters, schools and colleges in other States are still encouraged to be part of the initiative, knowing that they are doing something concrete (in addition to their proven prayers) to provide chaplains for the Armed Forces.
